This one call (811) is the FCC designated national abbreviated dialing code, and it provides advance notice of excavation activities to the people who need to know.

## Notes From The Mayor..



I want to update our residents on what we know about the Rabbinical College plans for the property on Route 306. No application for development has yet been submitted to the Village. When plans are submitted they will be carefully reviewed by the various village boards

in exactly the same manner as any other major development proposed for the village. We are not going to treat the developers of the college differently from any other applicant, and this includes not meeting with them before an application has been filed. As I have said before, we will be even-handed in our approach.

I have recently been asked about the construction that appears to have started in the "gravel pit" on Route 202, opposite Pacesetter and David's Bagels. This is not the beginning of construction of the rumored project of townhouses for the site. The owners have leased a small portion of their property for temporary storage of construction equipment and material for a different project. No plans for the development of the site have yet been filed with the Town of Haverstraw (no part of the site is in the Village of Pomona, although we will be part of the review process), but when they are, I will be sure to keep you informed.

Some of you have noted that the Haverstraw Town council recently authorized Supervisor Phillips to enter into a franchise agreement with Verizon for cable TV service in the town. Questions have been asked as to whether the Village of Pomona will also be getting this new service. Verizon made a presentation to the Village about 18 months ago to inform us of their FIOS project. We expect that as their build-out continues, they will be approaching the Village to sign a franchise agreement similar to Haverstraw's. When the time comes, the Village Board will carefully review the agreement and will determine whether to accept it based on the best interests of our residents.

Construction has stopped on the Route 202/Palisades Parkway bridge project. I have been in touch with the Department of Transportation and was informed that the project is being re-designed, and will most likely be re-bid when the new design is finished. Apparently the challenge of replacing the bridge while keeping the parkway open was not adequately considered in the original design. One benefit of the project, however, was the excellent job of re-paving the section of Parkway in the bridge area, and at least the barriers have been moved and the signs removed. Construction is unlikely to resume until next year at the earliest.
