

Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Dates for the rest of the year:

Saturdays - September 16, November 4
Sundays - October 15, December 3
and every weekday from 8:00 - 1:00 p.m.

This is the place to bring your mercury thermometers, smoke detectors, paint and paint products, resins, pool chemicals, pesticides, fungicides, herbicides, motor oil and filters, gasoline, anti-freeze, over the counter & prescription medications and many other items. The facility is located outside the Village of Pomona, off Pomona Road on Firemen's Memorial Drive (on the Route 45 end)

Are you aware that there is no overnight parking in the Village of Pomona? Also, between November 15th and April 1st, there is no parking from 12 midnight to 6:00 a.m. The Police Dept. will ticket offenders, so please be aware of the law.

Dogs

We also have a leash law in the Village which states that your dog, if not on his own property, must be on a leash, and not unlike New York City, we also have a Pooper Scooper Law! That is, if you are walking your dog on public property, you must clean up after him.




